<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have a sound understanding, and encourage players and team support officials to observe, respect and abide by the Club and District Club Rules and Codes at all times • Encourage the support and respect of the Clubs and District Clubs Codes of Conduct & Team Selection Policies • Ensure players understand and accept the Player code of conduct both on and off the field • Foster Club spirit amongst all players and encourage sportsmanship • Promote the sport of Rugby League and encourage players to be involved in a safe, healthy and enjoyable activity • Ensure appropriate training days, times and locations are understood by entire team • Introduce programs to improve player fitness levels for a healthier lifestyle • Encourage players to develop a positive attitude to competitiveness • Test, evaluate and develop each players individual skills • Set 'stretchable' and 'realistic' goals for players, encouraging participation, dedication and achievement • Enhance feelings of self-confidence and self-esteem within the players • Ensure the players perceive they are in control of their own performances • Be able to evaluate player performance and provide positive coaching advice
